The ORCSD School Board will hold a public budget hearing on the proposed 2024-2025 school budget at 7:00 p.m. on January 10, 2024, in the Oyster River Middle School Concert Hall.

Individuals wishing to file for a school district opening must do so <u>between Wednesday, 1/24, and up until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, 2/2/24</u>: one moderator position (1-year term) and three School Board members one each for Durham, Lee, and Madbury for the ensuing three years. There is no filing fee to register for placement on the ballot.
