ORCSD Care -

Many families chose to purchase the ORCSD Care program during enrollment through PowerSchool over the summer. If you chose to purchase the insurance but have yet to pay, there are two options to finalize payment which must be done by **Friday**, **October 13**. After this date, enrollment to the program may only be done after equipment inspection. 1) Send or bring \$20 cash or check to the ORHS front office. Check should be made payable to ORCSD and your student's name needs to be in the memo. If paying by cash, please seal in an envelope and put your student's name on the envelope. OR

2) Go to the Child Nutrition page on the district webpage. Choose LINQ Connect and login to account. Go to the navigation lines on the top left corner and enter the Store for ORCSD. Once in the store choose **ORCSD Care** and follow the provided instructions. In the Note section, include your student's name.

The PSAT/NMSQT for Juniors will be held on <u>Wednesday October 25th</u> during the school day. Students must arrive by 8:00am with their <u>fully charged school-issued computer</u>. Students should also bring a picture ID for checking in.

This is an optional test for Juniors. The cost is \$25, payable by cash or check made out to ORHS. (Fee waivers are available confidentially to eligible students, such as those who receive free/reduced lunch). The PSAT helps prepare Juniors for the SAT Test in the spring and depending on their score can qualify them for the National Merit Scholarship. <u>Students</u> <u>must sign up for the PSAT/NMSQT in the counseling office by October 20th at 3pm</u>.
