V. Old Business

1. Update of Foss Manufacturing "Plastic bottles collection project" - a meeting with Mark and the Foss representatives will be taking place on the 1-30th. Mark will share our comments from today and our 1-8-14 Steering meeting.

Maggie will ask Carrie at MW to see if the school would like to be involved with the pilot Foss initiative project.

We may want to develop a tool to decide in OUR District how WE think the Foss Initiative is going. Use compost "evaluation" system as a guide.

Are there really a lot of #1 bottles in our classrooms? Maggie is going to do some checking at MW to see how many bottles are used there.

Get from Foss an idea of the numbers of bottles they need to make the pilot project effective... maybe we are not the "right" District to use if we don't use enough bottles??

Include Jim Rozycki into the loop and ask him to attend the meeting with Mark and Foss reps.

What is our ultimate goal?... To get plastic out of the waste stream. If we don't allow bags of bottles on the buses then students can only bring bottles to school that fit in their backpacks. Bottles will be collected outside of school in some manner.

Bringing bottles in BAGS will need to be brought to schools by parents who drive over and drop off. Bags of bottles can't be brought to school on the buses.

Collecting bottles from athletic and afterschool events.....is this encouraging the purchasing of more bottles?

2. Green Team Leaders Update

<u>Stolworthy Land Meeting</u> - 8 people last week about the Stolworthy property and the adjacent land owner Rob Sullivan were present.

Discussion focused on how the land could be used. Teachers from the MS and HS use this land

for science, LA, social studies topics primarily.

MS- teachers use the land for water study

Ellen Synder has been hired by Town of Durham as a consultant to do Property "notebook"

A land management plan/Property Management Plan will be developed that will include: How can this land be used more as an outdoor classroom?

Jon Bromley talked with Vin Dell'ova to have HS students make a presentation to the Conservation Commission about topics of the Stolworthy/adjacent land beside HS Middle schoolers could make signage for the Stolworthy/adjacent land Teachers from OR who currently use this area will continue to use land for instruction. Establishing the District's science standards would be helpful... identifying a sustainability thread across the grades would be key

GT leaders reported that the <u>Power Down</u> went well... waiting to get bills from PSNH for Thanksgiving and Christmas time periods.

At the MS the custodians said only a few things were left on.

MW classrooms were checked and it was discovered that unplugging projector (ceiling) of Promethean Boards may not be prudent if it requires IT adjustment later on when plugged back in.

All school received snacks made supplied by GT and ORSC members to support their Power Down efforts. Mark said HS teachers were appreciative.

Jim R. continues to give Mary the Triano numbers so data from the Fall will be available soon.

MS- "Green Bean" Club- At the concert last night at HS with table for MS "Green Bean" recruitement. At the MS "Green Bean" Club meeting 2 new students attended. A mural is being painted by "The Makery" downtown in Durham. Consider asking the Art Club at the MS for their input/designing help

Other project ideas... Tote bags decorated with "green" logos and made by Green Bean members.

- MW- Meeting with Jim R, MW teachers, parents, minister with church about Rain garden will take place soon. This project will help improve the MW parking lot situation when it rains and the parking lot turns into a "lake." The rain garden will "absorb" some of this water so it pools less on the asphalt.
- HS- Two Igosr at HS will be rolled out on 27th. Signage made by the Sus Club is ready. Cyd is working on getting pictures/story for the special event.

Mary/Mark wil work on getting ice cream bars handed out to students who participate to help support a sense of celebration in the establishment of a new habit. Mark will work on getting some oversight with the HS students helping fellow students correctly sort recycling-compost-trash

Brian mentioned the HS Sus Club is strong with several initiatives. About 20 students attend.

Jan 27^{th} with HS administration and GT leaders to discuss next steps... How are we doing? How are the interactions with all the "players" in the HS (athletics, admin, teachers, students). Checking in to make sure everyone is onboard with similar goals.

"Get to Know" Events- Durham Public Library- Community Educational Outreach. Trifolds and information available. No one from the public came to the event on 1-15 that was offered by Maggie and Mary. Cristina will offer another event tonight.

3. Update of Community Dinner and Fed Up movie - January 8, 2015 GREAT evening ALL around!

Broad demographic of attendees... approx.. 200 people came for the dinner

Movie-80 visitors stayed for the entire movie. Approx. 25 people remained for the panel
discussion of UNH student on panel discussion with the lead support of Professor ______

One comment mentioned was-"Why did you pick "that" problem?" The movie focused on obesity, sugar consumption, nutrition, the food industry... "Why not problems that relate to us like air quality?"

Other comments: It was good to be reminded of how important food selection is in regards to nutrition/health.

Friday night (Keynote/expert introduction, then the movie, followed by a panel discussion) and then continue into Saturday afternoon 11-4pm
